ABOUT TS'I'TS' UWATUL' LELUM

Ts'i'ts'uwatul Lelum is a four-storey building providing 50 homes to Elders, seniors and people with disabilities.

Ts'i'ts'uwatul Lelum is a Coast Salish word in the Hul'qumi'num language meaning home for helping each other. Ts'i'ts'uwatul Lelum is pronounced Ts-ee-tsu-wa-tul Lay-lum.

FEATURES AND SERVICES

Our facility is situated close to essential services including medical professionals, pharmacy, grocery store, banks and coffee shops.

Hospitality and Services Include:

- Two meals per day (lunch and dinner), as well as snacks, served in the dining room
- Weekly light housekeeping
- Weekly linens (towels and sheets)
- 24-hour on-site emergency response
- Wireless (pendant) personal call system

Unique Housing Features Include:

- Activity / Craft room
- Outdoor gathering space
- Computers and internet access
- Theatre room
- Common laundry facilities
- Assisted bathing room



PERSONAL CARE

Trained community health workers are available to provide assistance with personal care and medication management as arranged by the Island Health.
